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ROCHESTER POLICE LOCUST CLUB, INC. 2018 – 2019 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

The Rochester Police Locust Club is proud to announce their 6th annual college scholarship application process with scholarships to be awarded to four applicants in the amount of \$1,500 each. Each award will be used for tuition and/or college-related expenses (\$750 per semester) for an incoming freshman attending a two-year community college and/or a four-year college or university. The Rochester Police Locust Club Scholarship Committee will pay the award for each semester directly to the scholarship winner for his/her tuition or college-related expenses.

One or more scholarships will be awarded to a 2018 graduating senior who is a City of Rochester resident and is currently attending a Rochester City School District high school or participating in the urban/suburban program. One or more scholarships will also be awarded to a son or daughter of an active member in good standing of the Rochester Police Locust Club. The applicants must be 2018 graduating seniors who attend a City of Rochester high school and/or suburban high school.

In order to accept their scholarship award, the winners must be present at the Rochester Police Department's & Rochester Police Locust Club's annual Awards Dinner which will be held in May 2018 (formal date to be announced). Award winners and two additional guests will be guests of the Rochester Police Locust Club. Additional guests of the winners are invited to the event but will be required to purchase a ticket for the event. In the event that a scholarship award winner is unable to attend the event, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to excuse the recipient from attendance or may elect to award the scholarship to an alternate scholarship award winner.

The Rochester Police Locust Club Scholarship Committee will present the first semester award upon confirmation that the recipient has been admitted, enrolled as a full-time student and has commenced attendance. The second semester award will be presented after proof of successful completion of the first semester with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

In order to apply for the Rochester Police Locust Club scholarship, all 2018 graduating applicants must have a minimum high school GPA of 85 with a minimum SAT score of 1000 (combined mathematics score and critical reasoning score) or an ACT composite score of 20 or higher.

All the below listed **REQUIRED** information must be submitted to the Rochester Police Locust Club Scholarship Committee, 1425 Lexington Avenue, Rochester, New York 14606 and/or postmarked **no later than March 16, 2018**.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Completed application
2. High school transcript showing a minimum GPA of 85 and SAT score (minimum score 1000) or ACT (minimum score 20 or higher)
3. Typed 500-word essay on the following topic: *"How have both your academic studies and extracurricular activities contributed to your personal development and future plans?"*
4. Résumé to include extracurricular activities, community service and employment experiences
5. Two letters of recommendation
